The film *Abandoned* focuses on a particular dark subject:

The repercussions of life in a post-peasant, patriarchal family, in a time before equal rights of men and women in Austria. Children who were treated as bondslaves, fathers who drowned their capitalist powerlessness in alcohol - resulting in violence.

Set in the Carinthian borderland where for hundreds of years conflicts between the Slavic and German ethnic group were all too apparent and that, in the time before Austria's accession to the European Union (EU), was governed by a toothless military administration, the main character has to return to his place of suffering.

Abandoned: Interpretation – Concept of the Author



Abandoned is a personal film set in Carinthia. The plot combines own experience and individual stories from other people from the region around Klagenfurt and family affairs that have marked the last few decades of the last century to an almost intimate play-like tragedy. In some places a sternness of people arose directly from the harshness of nature. The breadearner called the shots and was allowed to treat people like cattle. The cruelty of people, sexual assault, military, alcoholism, addictions had an impact on the life of children. In the seclusion of the mountains there were no witnesses. A lot of things happened behind closed doors. How can you forget anything when violence was the rule, a daily occurrence? How can a new generation cope with this burden and escape it to make their own life better?

Abandoned: At first sight, Pauli had been abandoned by his mother and father – at second glance also by zest for life/vitality and hope.

David Hofer and Michael Kuglitsch have been making films in Carinthia for several years. The switch from genre to genre, driven by their insatiable desire to tell their stories and entertain people with the means of cinematography.
